



## REENTRY PLAN

After a summer of outdoor worship, we look forward to gathering again inside the building beginning Sunday, October 25. We will host in-person services with live teaching and worship at 9:00 & 11:00. To make sure our reentry is as safe as possible, please stay informed of the many changes we're incorporating to keep you safe.

## PRECAUTIONS

- Recommended distancing guidelines will be in place, including reduced seating capacities. Our auditorium will be set up at about 30% of our typical capacity.
- Hand-sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the building.
- We expect everyone over the age of 8 to wear a face covering while inside the building. If you forgot one, don't worry. We have one for you!
- All doors will be open with the exception of bathroom stalls.
- Following each service, high-volume areas and seating will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected including all adult and children's classrooms.
- Coffee stations and water fountains will not be available at this time.
- Restrooms will be available and frequently cleaned.
- Offering plates and communion trays will not be passed. Communion will be pre-placed on each chair.

Let's be realistic. No one enjoys all of these precautions. Is it fun singing or talking with a mask on? No and no. These precautions are a huge adjustment for all of us. If you dislike this, we get it. The bottom line is that we want to care for and love each other well. As we regather, let's be sure to exhibit grace and patience as we strive to worship and serve together.



## MORE DETAILS

### WHO?

We want to offer those who want to worship in person an opportunity to do so. However, if you've been experiencing symptoms such as a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher, cough or runny nose, or stomach issues; or, if in the last 14 days or you have had in-person contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19, please stay home and join us online for our services. If you have an underlying medical condition, believe you are in a high-risk category, or you are over the age of 65 we recommend you stay home and continue worshipping with us online. That being said, we won't turn you away at the door unless you're showing symptoms.

### WHAT CAN BE EXPECTED AT THIS LIMITED REOPENING?

Live worship, a live host, and live teaching. Approximately 60 minutes. But don't expect delicious coffee, donuts, or water fountains.

### ARE RESERVATIONS FOR ADULTS OR KIDS REQUIRED?

Nope! We'll be ready for you and your kiddos.

### ARE KIDS WELCOME?

Yes, as long as they are healthy! Venture Kids has already begun regathering. Programming will be available for children nursery through 6th grade. Since Venture Kids began regathering, we have been and will continue to make tweaks weekly!

### WHAT IS THERE FOR MY STUDENT?

Root 56 will resume on October 25 at 11am. Junior & Senior High will resume on November 8 at 11am.

### WHY IS THERE SUCH A LONG TIME BETWEEN SERVICES NOW?

We want to make sure that we have ample time to thoroughly clean high-traffic areas such as children's spaces, restrooms, and seating areas between services. This time frame also allows for those attending our first service to fully leave the building minimizing the exposure and risk to larger numbers of people.

### WHAT ABOUT FACE COVERINGS?

We get it. No one likes them, but we expect everyone 8+ to wear one while in the building. This is not for your safety as much as it's for the safety of others, including our volunteers and staff. Masks will be available if you do not have one. Staff and volunteers will be required to wear one.
